Cats top Warriors, 23-0 to stay unbeaten

Fifth-ranked Catamounts overcome turnovers, rain to defeat Eastern CT State

Burlington, VT – October 8, 2014: The University of Vermont Catamounts battled the weather, along with a talented Eastern Connecticut State team, in a 23-0 victory that elevated the Cats to 3-0 on the season. Catamount QB Jason Paul had two interceptions to go with his two TD tosses in a rainy, windy affair that slowed down the offenses of both teams. The Catamount defense had three interceptions of their own, and recorded their first shutout of the season.

QB Jason Paul was 8-23 for 147 yards on the day, while WR's Jake Bielecki and Pat Nee each recorded a TD reception for the third consecutive week. Nee was the leading receiver for Vermont with 68 yards on two receptions. Patrick Shea led Vermont rushers with 59 yards on eight carries and a score. Ryan Ragosta led the defense with seven tackles and one sack, and Blake Walker, Liam Coleman, and Adam Levine each had interceptions for the Cats.

Fifth-ranked UVM will resume YCFC play against Clarkson University on Sunday October 12. Kickoff time is 1:00 PM at South Burlington High School.
